### What is the Arian Heresy?

The Council of Nicaea, 325 AD		
St. Athanasius & St. Nicholas	Arius	
• Jesus is the <b>same substance</b> as the Father	<ul> <li>Jesus is not the same substance as the Father.</li> <li>Jesus is not God</li> </ul>	
• Jesus <b>is</b> God	Homoiosios (similar substance)	
<ul> <li>Homoousios (same substance)</li> <li>People voted and agreed with Athanasius and not Arius.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Arius was branded a heretic (someone that goes against the teachings of the Church)</li> <li>Arius was exiled.</li> </ul>	

The Nicene Creed was created to confirm the belief in the Trinity.

This is still said at every Mass today.

The Nicene Creed	Explanation
'We believe in one God'	Catholics believe in one God in three persons
'The Father, the Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth'	The Father is the <b>creator</b>
'We believe in One Lord Jesus Christ consubstantial with one being the Father'	Jesus is God and the <b>same substance</b> as the Father
'We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord the giver of life'	The Holy Spirit gives us <b>life</b>

#### Jesus

Christ—Greek word for Messiah.

Meaning saviour.

LORD-God.

**Son of God**—Reminder of Jesus' **divine nature** (God like).

**Son of Man**—Reminder of Jesus' human nature.

'Imitators of God' Ephesians

**Forgiveness**— 'Forgive seventy times seven times' **Luke** 

**Servanthood**— 'Now that I have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet' **John** 

**Love for others**—'Love your neighbour' **Luke** 

God incarnate (God in human form)

- Allows us to understand God's nature e.g. loving
- Model example e.g. Forgiv
- Help us to understand what God wanted (law)
