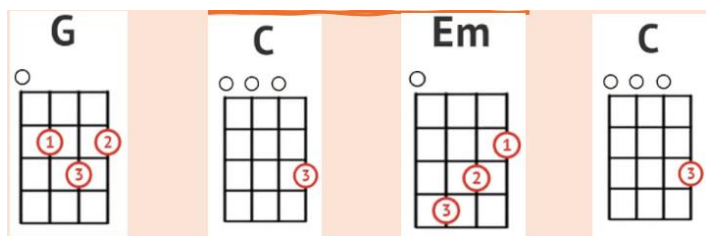
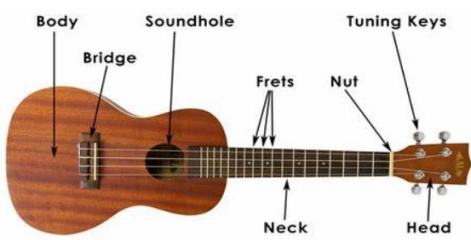
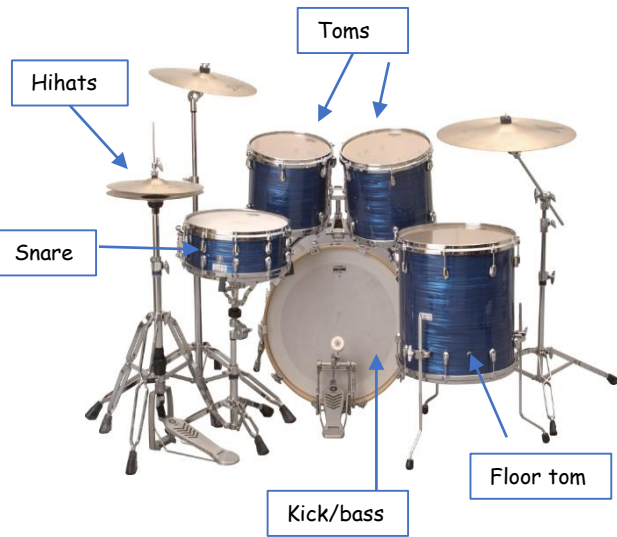
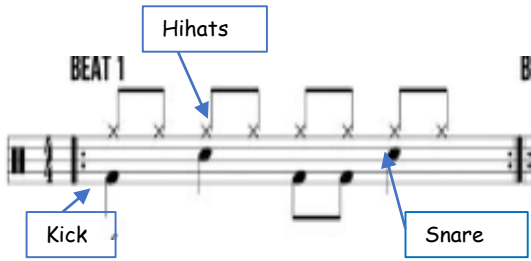


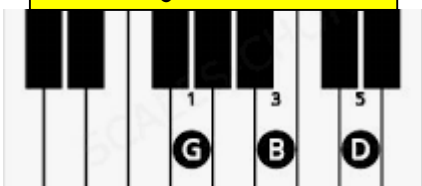
# Music – Textures and layers

## Key words and Vocabulary

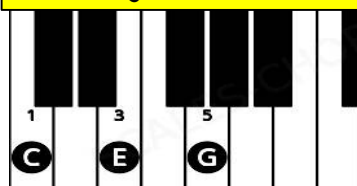
- **Texture** - the different layers of sound within a song or piece of music. Thick or thin texture
- **Layers** - The different instruments and their roles within a band
- **Beat** - a pulse heard or felt throughout the song
- **Chord** - a collection of 3 or more notes played at the same time
- **Major chord** - sounds happy and uplifting
- **Minor chord** - sounds sad and depressing
- **Chord progression** - a series of chords throughout a song, often held on for 4 beats each
- **Rock band** - vocals/guitars/bass/keyboards/drums
- **Guitars/keyboards/Ukuleles** - often play the chords
- **Bass Guitar** - plays the low notes
- **Vocalist** - sings the lyrics
- **Drums** - Keeps the beat for everyone to stay in time with each other
- **Hihats/toms/kick/snare/cymbals** - Parts of the drum kit
- **Musescore** - A software package for writing music on
- **Ensemble performance** - playing in a group
